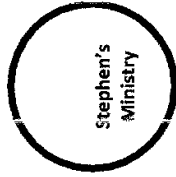
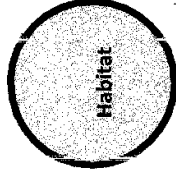
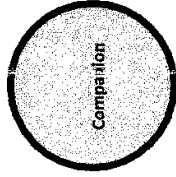
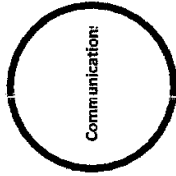
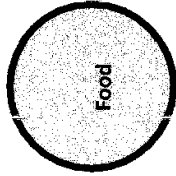
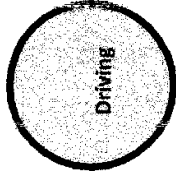
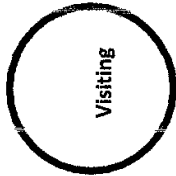


Congregational Caring Ministry


Welcoming
