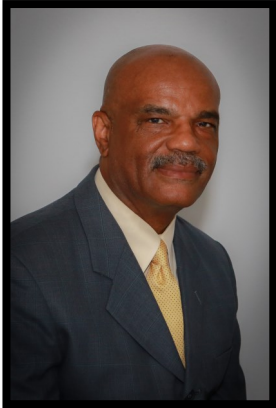

Some Thoughts About September

September always reminds me of freshly sharpened pencils. I love the smell of a freshly sharpened pencil. I remember in the days before school started getting all of my school supplies lined up and ready. Crayons had to be fresh, folders had to be unmarked, and pencils had to be sharpened. I was generally a disorganized child, by the end of the year all of my folders were bent and drawn on, and I couldn't keep a paper unwrinkled to save my life, but on the first day of school, everything was in order and had its place. I envy the refresh that children get when they enter a new grade of school, they have the chance every September to remake themselves and start anew. As adults we have no clear moment in the year where we can start over. We live with our wrinkled papers and drawn on folders, occasionally starting on one new thing or another, but we don't have a time for a collective reset like children do. I wonder what that reset might look like, especially one that was done together as a church. What might we see if we took a moment to look together at what we have and asked ourselves what needed to be reset or refreshed not only with ourselves, but within our church. Things may look different, things may look the same, but it may feel nice to come into church with sharpened pencils.

Sunday School

Sunday School resumes on September 17th! Sunday School is targeted to elementary age students, but students up to 12th grade are welcome. We will continue using Deep Blue's One Room School House Curriculum this year. This fall we will be learning more about the story of David, Starting with the time just before David, and continuing through to his son Solomon. This fall we will also be trying Sunday School every Sunday rather than taking off the first of the month. We hope that this consistency will make Sundays a little bit easier on parents and allow them to be present while in the pews. Children are always welcome in our sanctuary whether there is Sunday School or not, but we understand that for parents, attending to children can sometimes be a distraction from the service, and we want to make sure that parents are able to worship separately from their children if they would like.

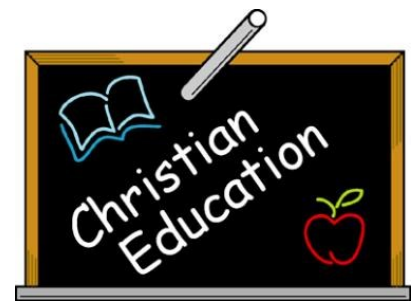


Family Excursions

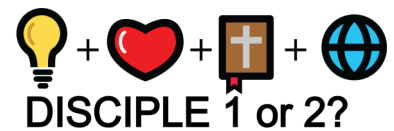

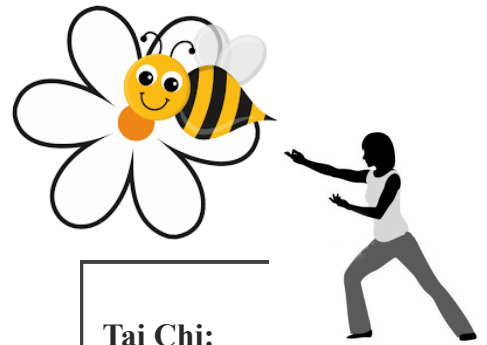

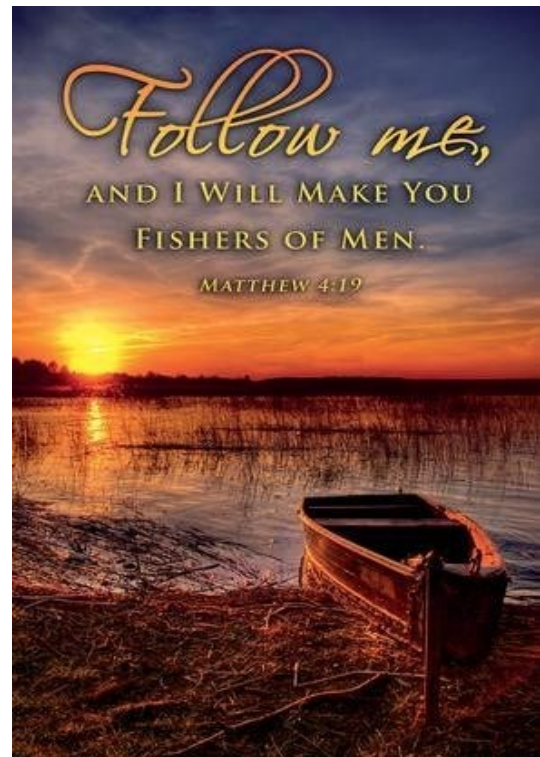
